- 2) Rising Sophomore, Junior, or Senior student in college.
- 3) Exercises leadership in college, extra-curricular and/or civic activities.
- 4) Involved in a program (on or off campus) that addresses/promotes social justice, gives back to the community, or where the student engages in service to others.

Applicants will be notified in early May of their status. Winners will be recognized at the Future Philanthropists Program capstone event on May 18, 2017
